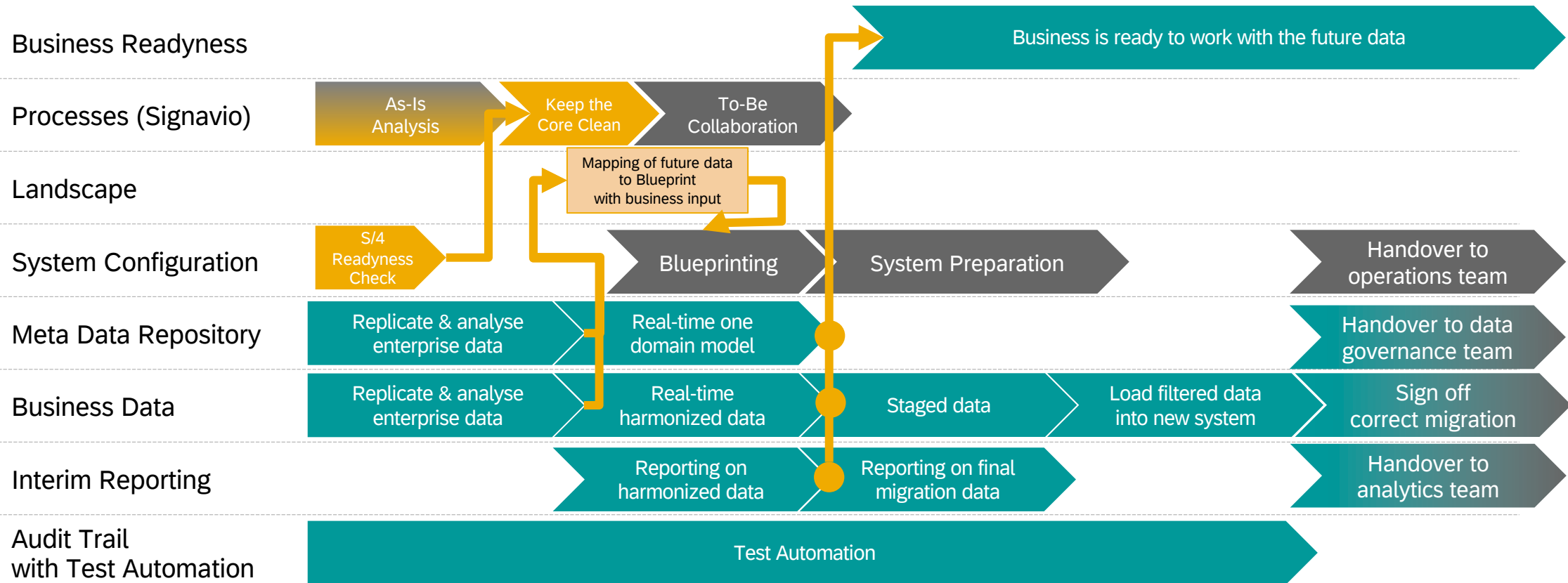

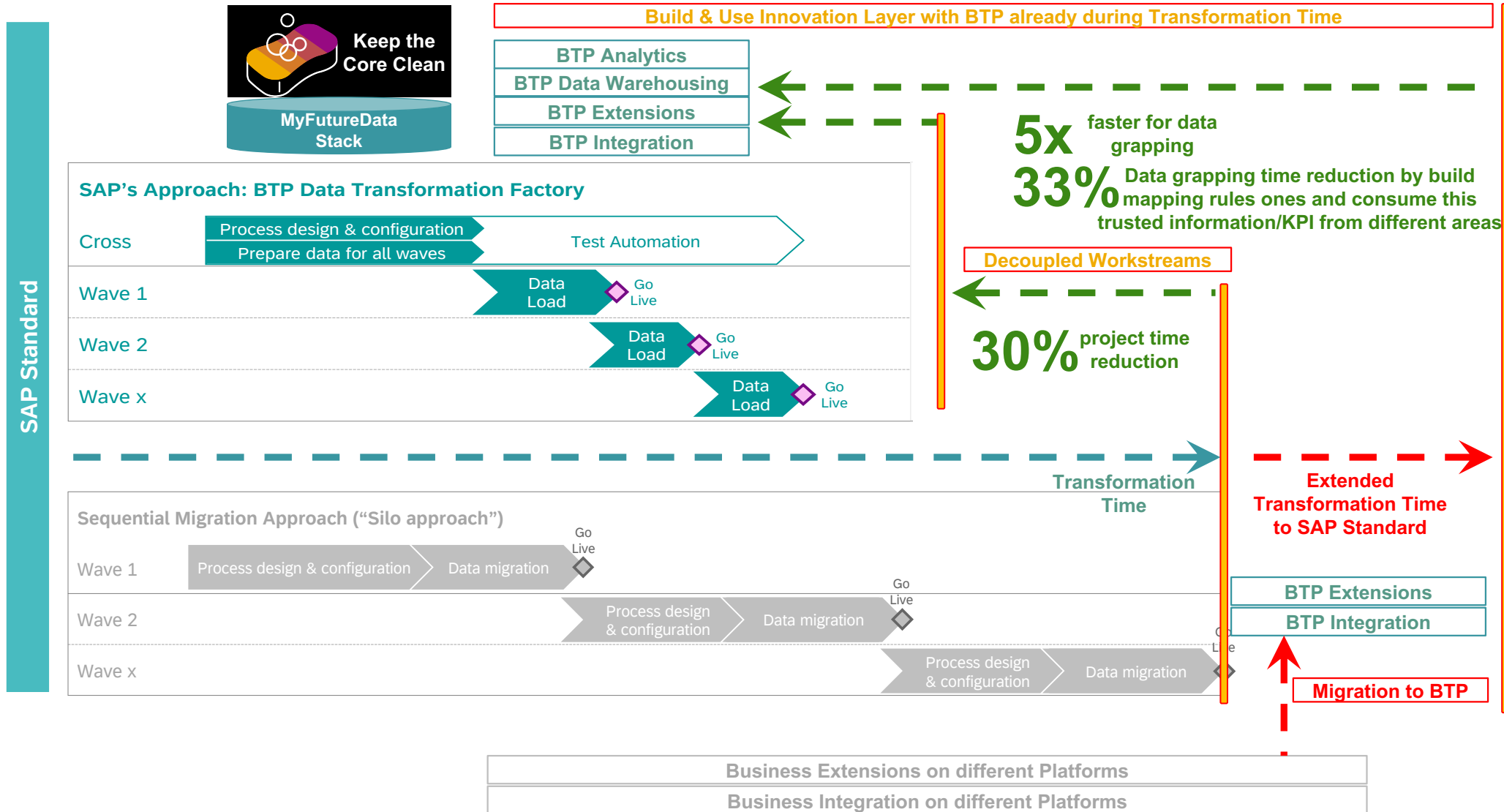

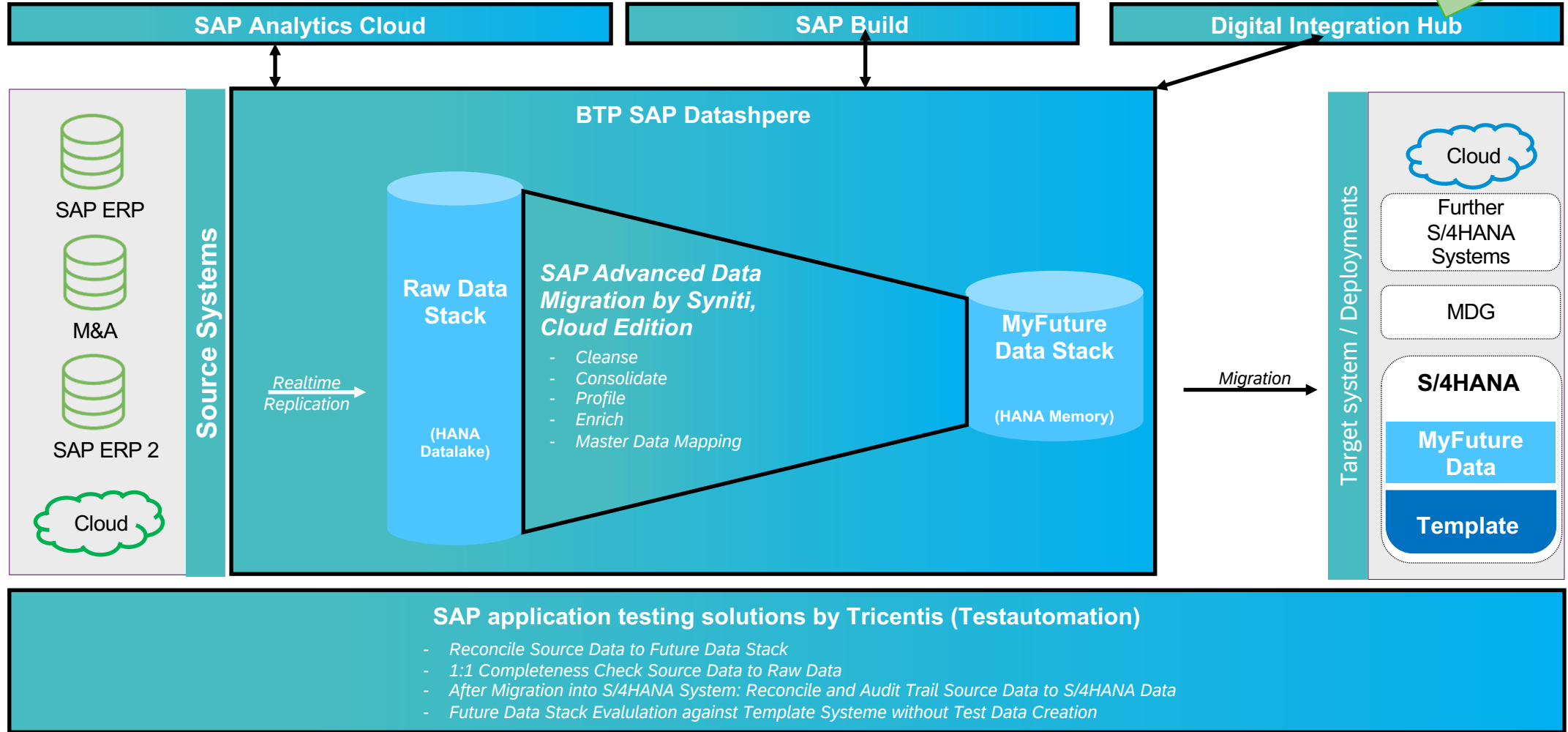
# MyFutureData Stack as the Single Source of Truth

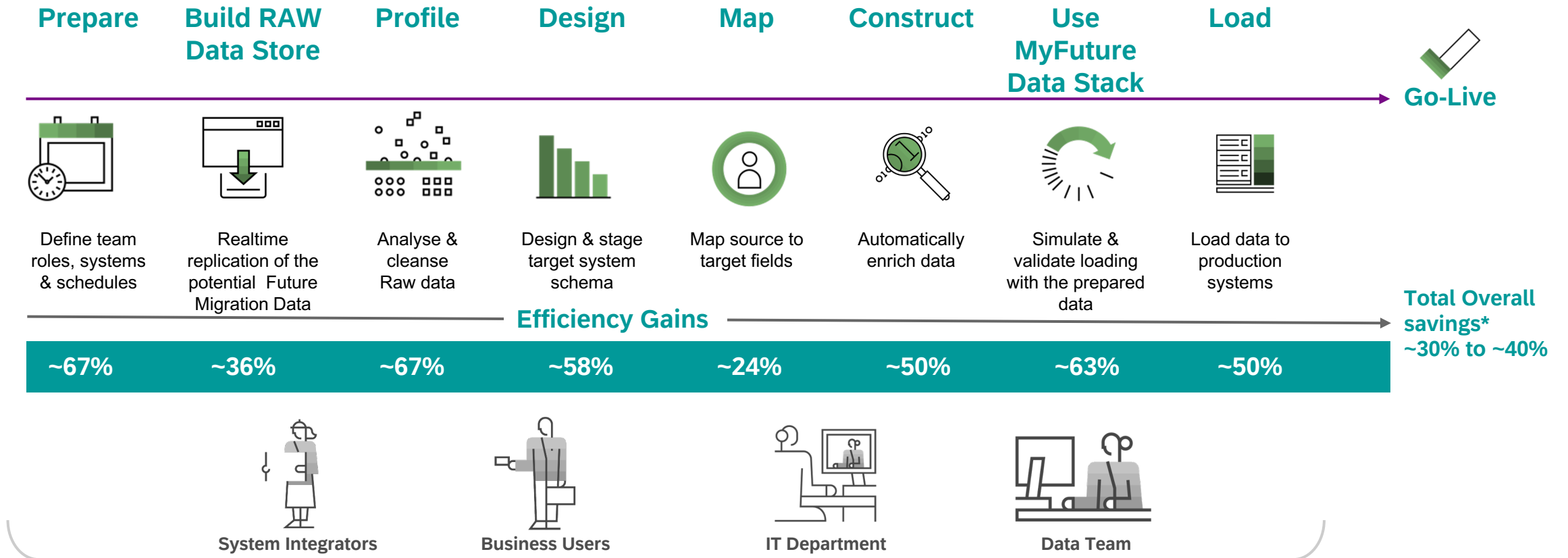

# The Eight Steps of the Transformation Process

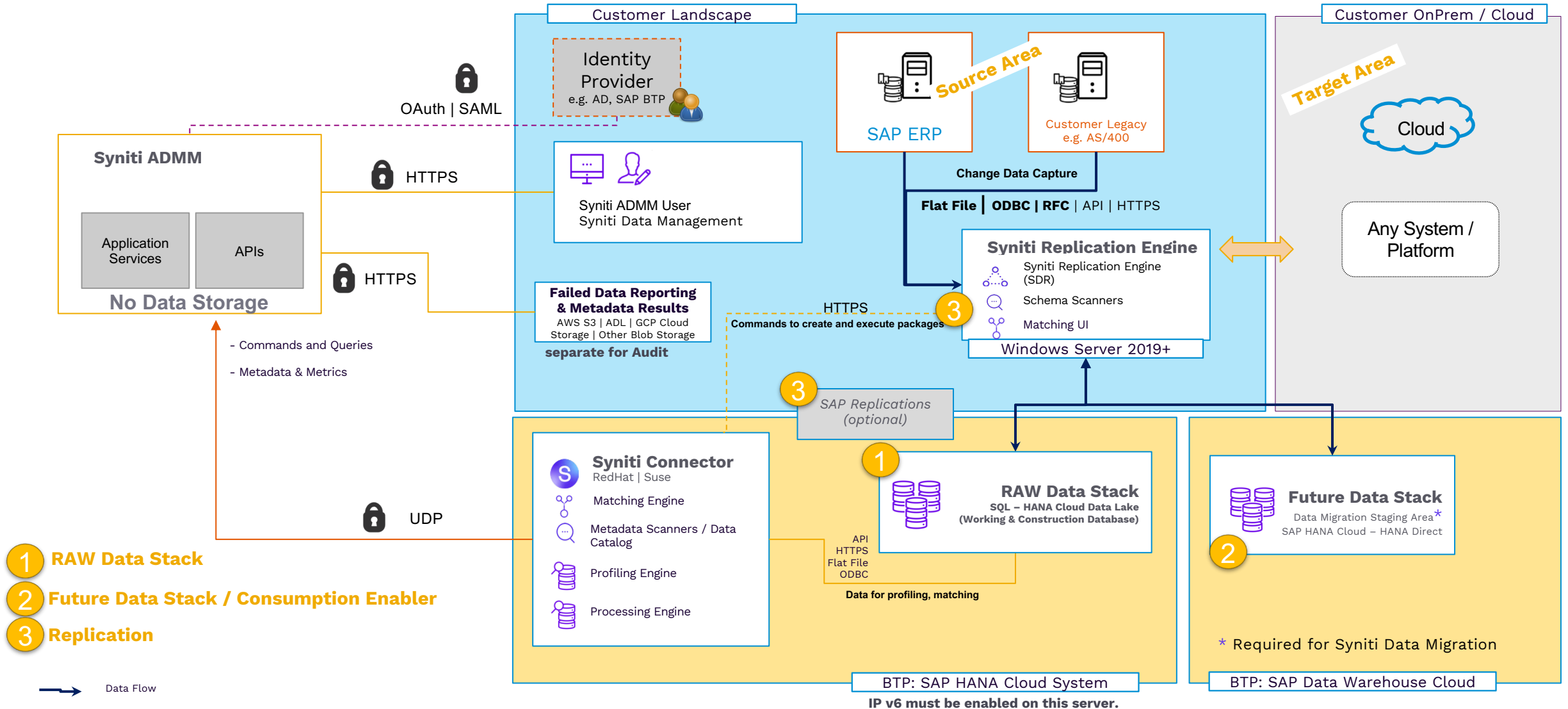
